Notice is hereby given that Plaintiff CHRISTIAN MEISTER, proceeding Pro Se (hereinafter "MEISTER"), appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the ELEVENTH CIRCUIT, from the herein listed Orders denying the herein listed Motions, as follows:
